Reefer madness, dangerous men, and even more dangerous women populated the tunes performed by artists both black and white. Their version of Harlem was charged with an air of the exotic.

The neighbourhood was seen as a place of ongoing jubilation, even as the Great Depression ravaged its African-American population. It inspired all sorts of musical

tributes, from hipster-jive swing songs to extended concert works by James P Johnson, Benny Carter and Duke Ellington (WFIU)
